A. **Eligibility:** Candidates should have at least three years of experience in the Northshore School District. The selection committee will require that candidates present a proposal in writing for detailing how additional education or training will assist them in meeting their goal to maintain ongoing service or to advance within the Northshore School District. Specific schooling objectives and desired results are to be included in the proposal.

Letters of recommendation should be included from individuals with whom the candidate works or has worked in the field of education.

B. **Scholarship Use:** The scholarship may be used at a four-year accredited college or university and is limited to use for tuition and fees.

C. **Selection Criteria:** Candidates may be interviewed by a Scholarship Committee appointed by the Woodinville Rotary Club and members of the family of Dr. Forys.

D. **Process:** All applicants must complete this written application. This form and all written documents should be submitted to the Scholarship Program Coordinator of the Foundation at the post office box address listed above. Applications received past the deadline of **April 23, 2010** will not be considered.
