This application is to be used by candidates who presently are engaged in service within the Northshore School District and desire to achieve accreditation in his or her selected education field. The application should be submitted to the Foundation at P O Box 173, Bothell Wa 98041.

Applications **must be received** no later than the posted deadline of **March 1, 2010**

1. General Information

A. **Eligibility:** Candidates should either have (1) at least two years of experience as a paraeducator in the school district, or (2) have at least one-year experience as a paraeducator in the school district and possess a bachelor's or associate of arts degree in the field of education. The selection committee will require that candidates present a proposal in writing for detailing how additional education or training will assist them in meeting their goal to maintain ongoing service or to advance within the Northshore School District. Specific schooling objectives and desired results are to be included in the proposal.

Letters of recommendation should be included from individuals with whom the candidate works or has worked in the field of education.

B. **Scholarship Use:** The scholarship may be used at a two-year or a four-year accredited college or university, or an accredited technical or trade school. The scholarship is limited to use for tuition and fees.

C. **Selection Criteria:** Candidates will be interviewed by a Scholarship Committee appointed by the Kiwanis Club of Northshore and the Matthews family.

D. **Process:** All applicants must complete this written application. This form and all written documents should be submitted to the Scholarship Program Coordinator of the Foundation at the post office box address listed above. Some scholarship selection committees will wish to interview finalists. Applications received past the deadline of March 1, 2010 will not be considered. Successful candidate will be notified no later than May 1, 2010.
